## Installation of jquery themes in osCommerce 2.3.4

### Simple installation of theme packages downloaded from shopwebshop.eu

Prerequisites: You have an installed osCommerce 2.3.4 webshop in a web host, eg one.com. You have a personal computer with internet access and a web browser and a FTP - program, such as Filezilla. NOTE: The images in this guide are from when I installed jquery theme "Sunny", but other themes are installed the same way.

Note, for osCommerce is installed without the "catalog" folder at the top, see Special Cases below.

Commands and programs in this document has been made from a local Linux system, but if you are using a Windows computer locally, you can find similar commands and programs to use. NOTE! In order to edit in Windows, you must install Notepad ++ first, because the editor understands and can store text files in UNIX, UTF-8 format.

The default theme of osCommerce 2.3.4 looks like this:

Create a new folder on your local computer with the same name as the theme you want to install, for example, "sunny".

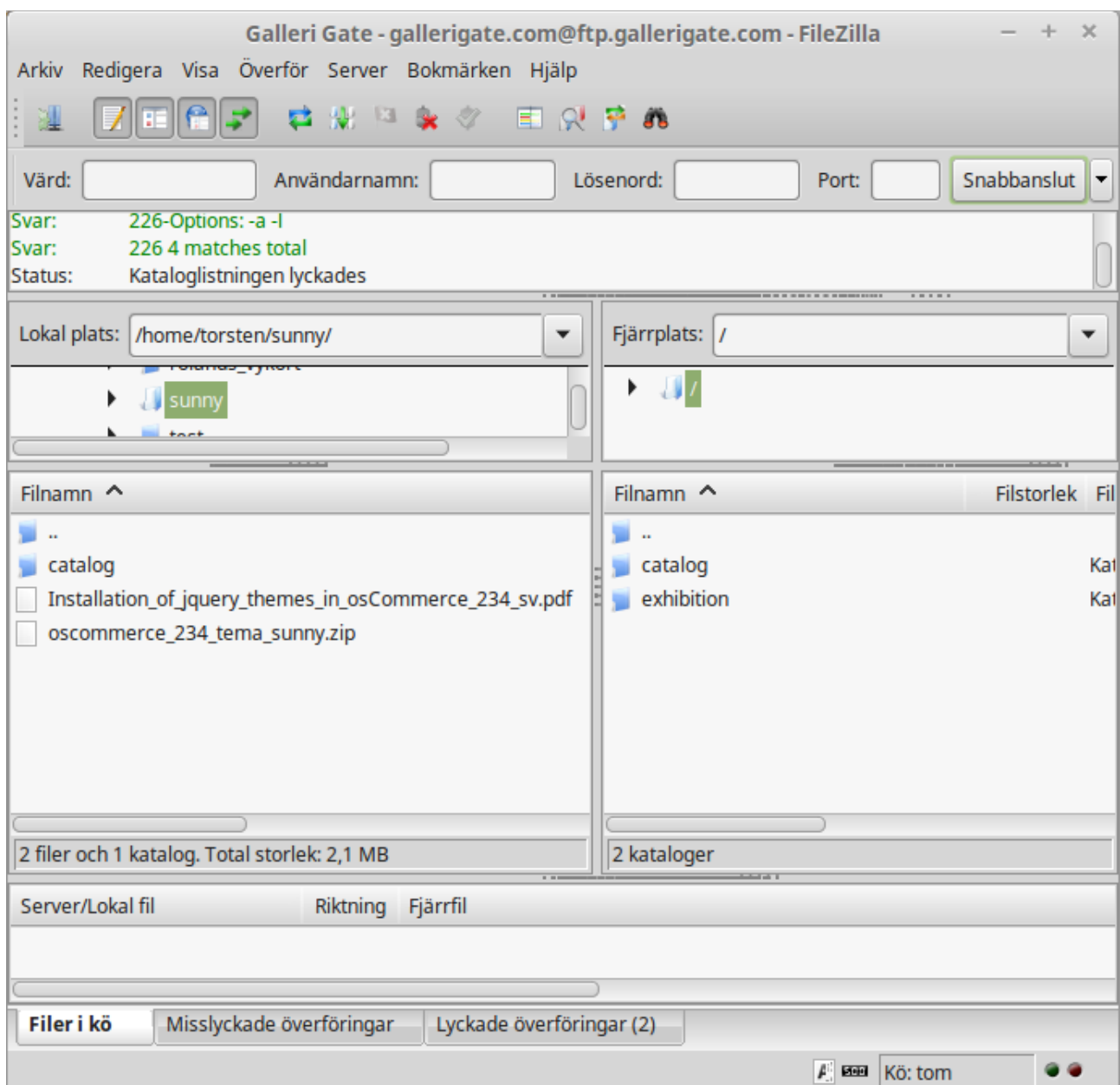
Download the theme's zip file to that directory. Click into this catalog.

Unzip the zip - file. In Linux, use unzip, and windows extract, extract all.

Start an FTP program such as Filezilla. Navigate to the directory where you unzipped the theme of, "sunny" in the left pane of Filezilla. Du see the catalog "catalog", a pdf file and the zip file there.

Connect to your online store with FTP login data that you received from your hosting provider or created in the control panel there.

You should now see the "catalog" folder in the right pane of Filezilla, otherwise, see Special Cases below.



Now drag and drop the directory "catalog" from left to right, and make sure not to drop it in a directory but in a blank spot or a file list in the right pane.  
(Drag and Drop: You point the mouse cursor on the "catalog" folder and click and hold the left mouse button while you move it to the right pane, as mentioned above, and release the left mouse button where you want to drop it.)  
Now file transfer complete!

If you are surfing into your web shop as a customer you will see the new theme "Sunny".

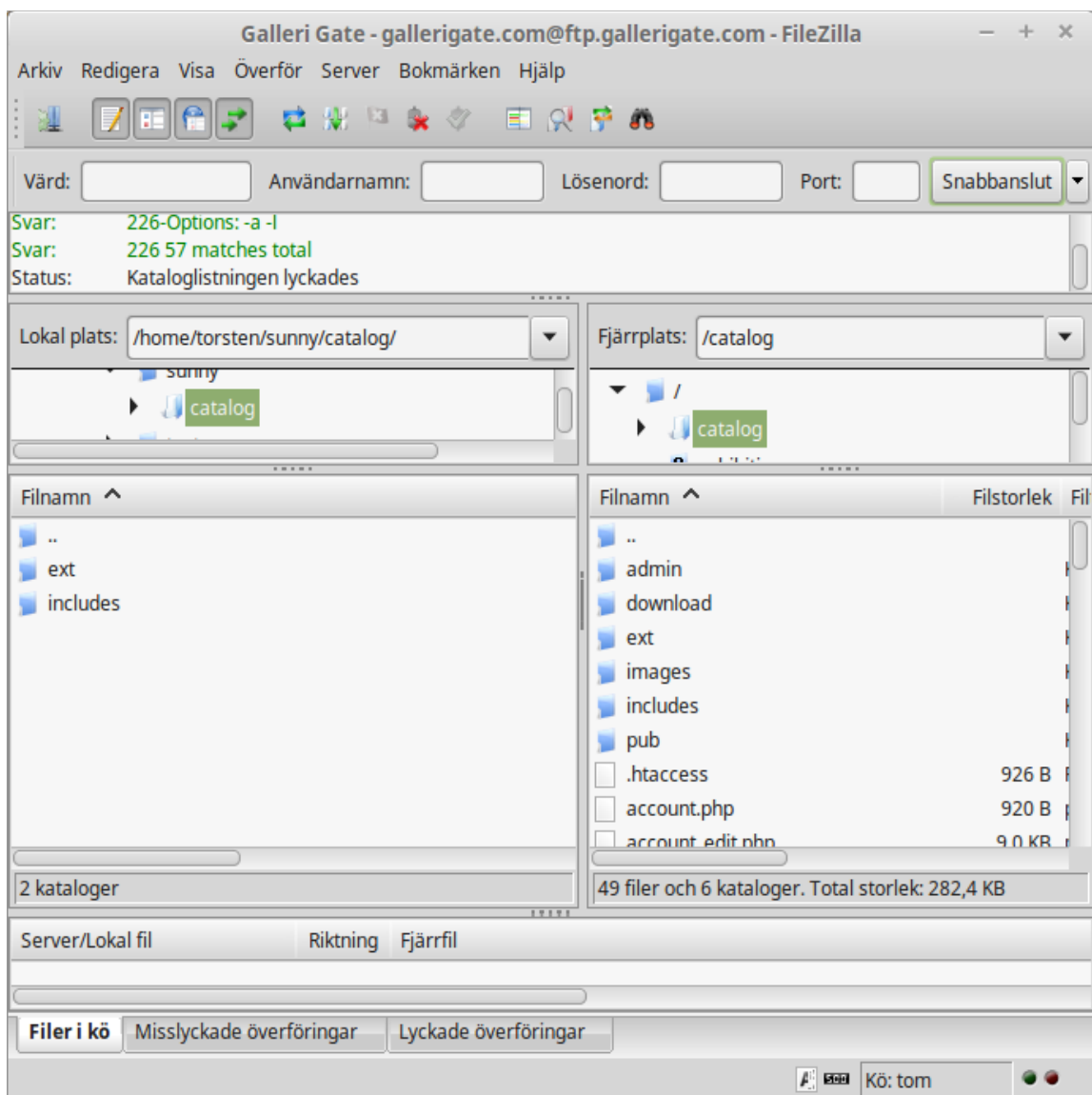

## Special Cases

### If osCommerce 2.3.4 is installed without the catalog directory

You can install osCommerce without the initial "catalog" directory if you want the index file `index.php` under your website root. It may be the case if you only have this osCommerce web shop on your website. In other cases, for example, if you have a previous site where you want to add an osCommerce online store with a link in it the standard installation of the directory catalog is better. If you installed the osCommerce 2.3.4 right to your webroot, without the initial catalog directory, ie, if you copied everything's under catalog from the left side of Filezilla to / on the right side. Then you click into the catalog directory on the left side of the theme package and copy directories "ext" and "includes" to / on the right side.

Drag and drop folders "ext" and "includes" from left to right, and make sure not to drop them in a directory but in a blank spot or a file list in the right pane.

(Drag and Drop: You point the mouse cursor on the "ext" directory and click and hold the left mouse button while you move it to the right pane, as mentioned above, and release the left mouse button where you want to drop it.) Do the same with "includes" directory.  
Now file transfer complete!

## Download theme itself from jqueryui.com and install

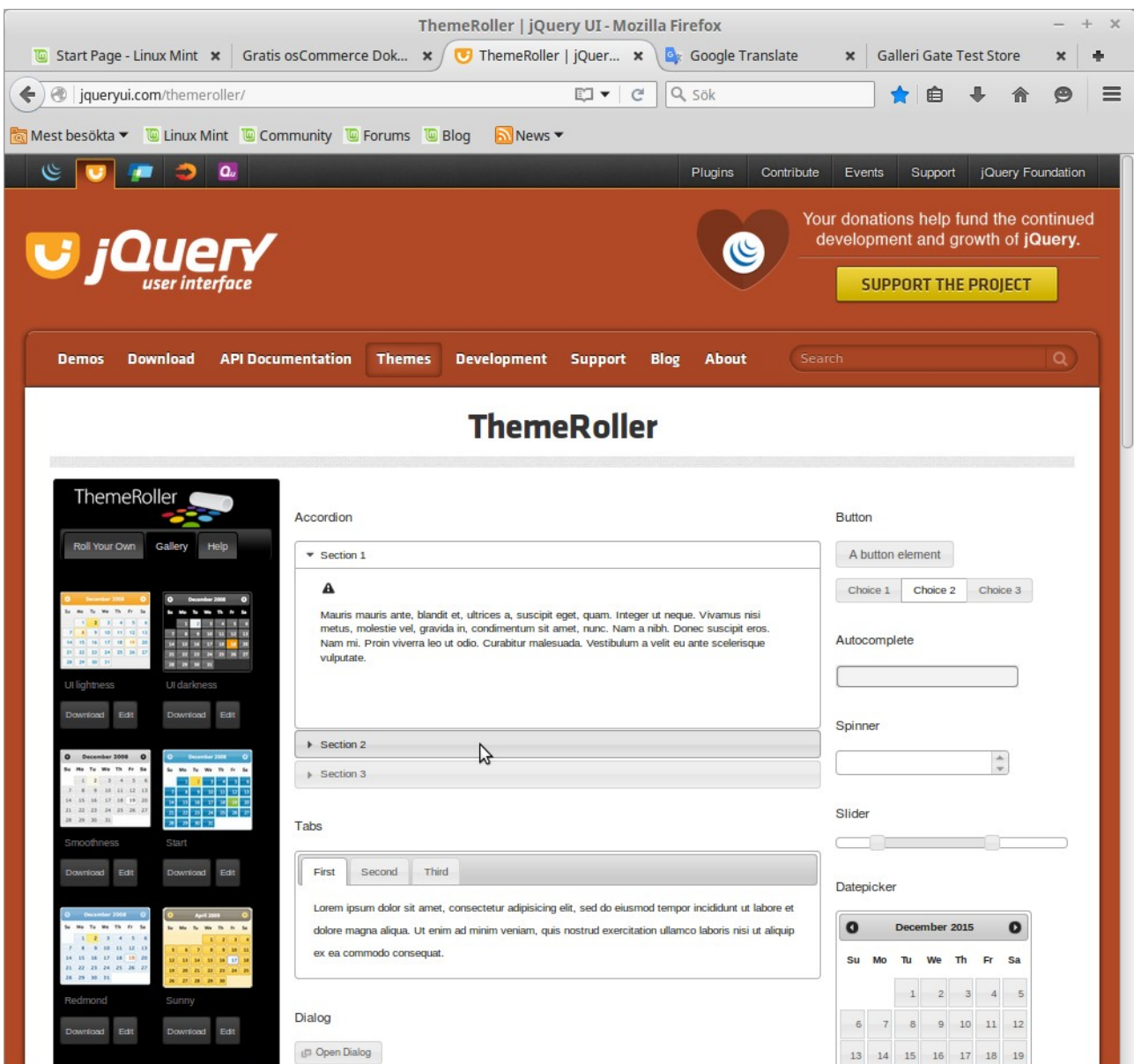

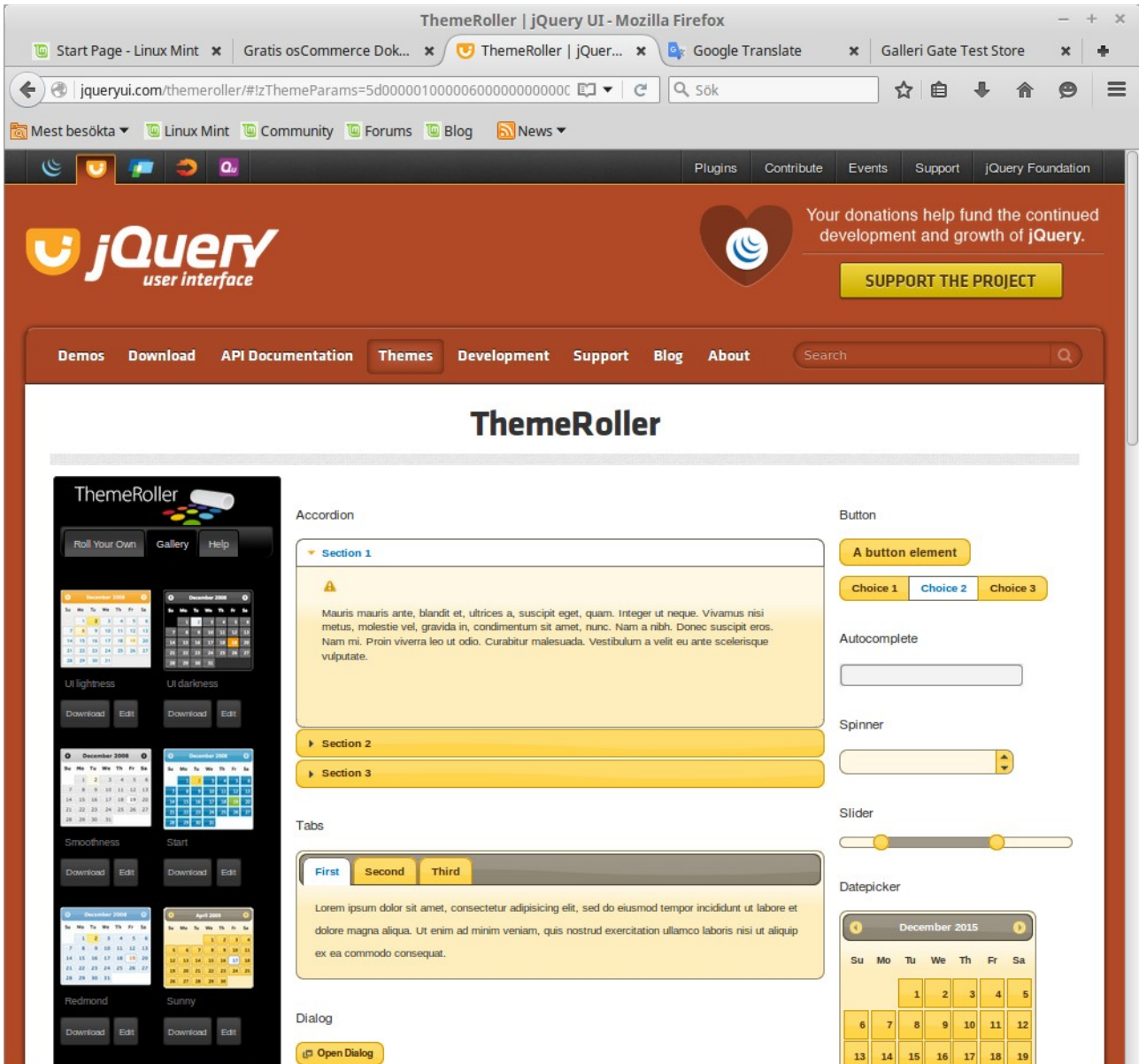
Here you can create your own theme if you want under the tab "Roll Your Own", but it is much simpler to edit a ready-made theme. You can immediately see how the theme looks to the right while you fill in the color, etc. in 11 different tabs. When you are ready, click on the "Download theme" button. This displays the Download Builder, scroll at the bottom of the page and click on the "Download" button. Save the zip file in a directory with a name that corresponds to the theme's name.

If you want to download a ready made theme instead, open the tab "Gallery". There are 24 different themes there.



If you click a ready-made theme here eg "Sunny"

then it will appear on the right how all the elements look like:



Under each theme there is a button "Download" to download the theme, and a "Edit" button to edit the theme. If it's just a few details that you want to change, it is easiest to use the "Edit" button. The chosen theme will then be opened under the tab "Roll Your Own", and when you are finished, you download the theme described above.

Note !!! The downloaded package always have the same name "jquery-ui-1.11.4.custom.zip", so if you download more themes, move the downloaded package to its own directory, otherwise it will be difficult to keep track of which is which, and there is risk of overwriting. Note !!!



Unzip the zip file, then a subdirectory will be created called "jquery-ui-1.11.4.custom". Open that folder, you will see the directories "external" and "images" and a number of files, including the file jquery-ui.min.css to be accessed from the file template\_top.php. All this should be transferred to the web shop. First, create the directory (folder name must be unique and correspond to the theme name) for the theme on the webshop eg catalog/ext/jquery/ui/sunny , and transfer everything to this directory.

Edit a local copy of the file catalog/includes/template\_top.php . You can copy the file from the folder of the osCommerce download.

Change line 29:

```
<link rel = "stylesheet" type = "text/css" href = "ext/jquery/ui/redmond/jquery-ui-1.10.4.min.css" />  
to
```

```
<link rel = "stylesheet" type = "text/css" href = "ext/jquery/ui/sunny/jquery-ui.min.css" />
```

save it and upload it to the webshop with the FTP program.

If you want to get back the default theme redmond, then just change back line 29 in the file catalog/includes/template\_top.php to the original:

```
<link rel = "stylesheet" type = "text/css" href = "ext/jquery/ui/redmond/jquery-ui-1.10.4.min.css" />
```

and transfer the file to the web shop via FTP. The other files for the default theme redmond is still in the webshop.

Tip: When you install multiple themes in your webshop, simply transfer the file catalog/includes/template\_top.php from the theme package to activate, via FTP to your webshop to change the theme. The Themes other files will remain in the webshop for all the theme packages that you installed!
